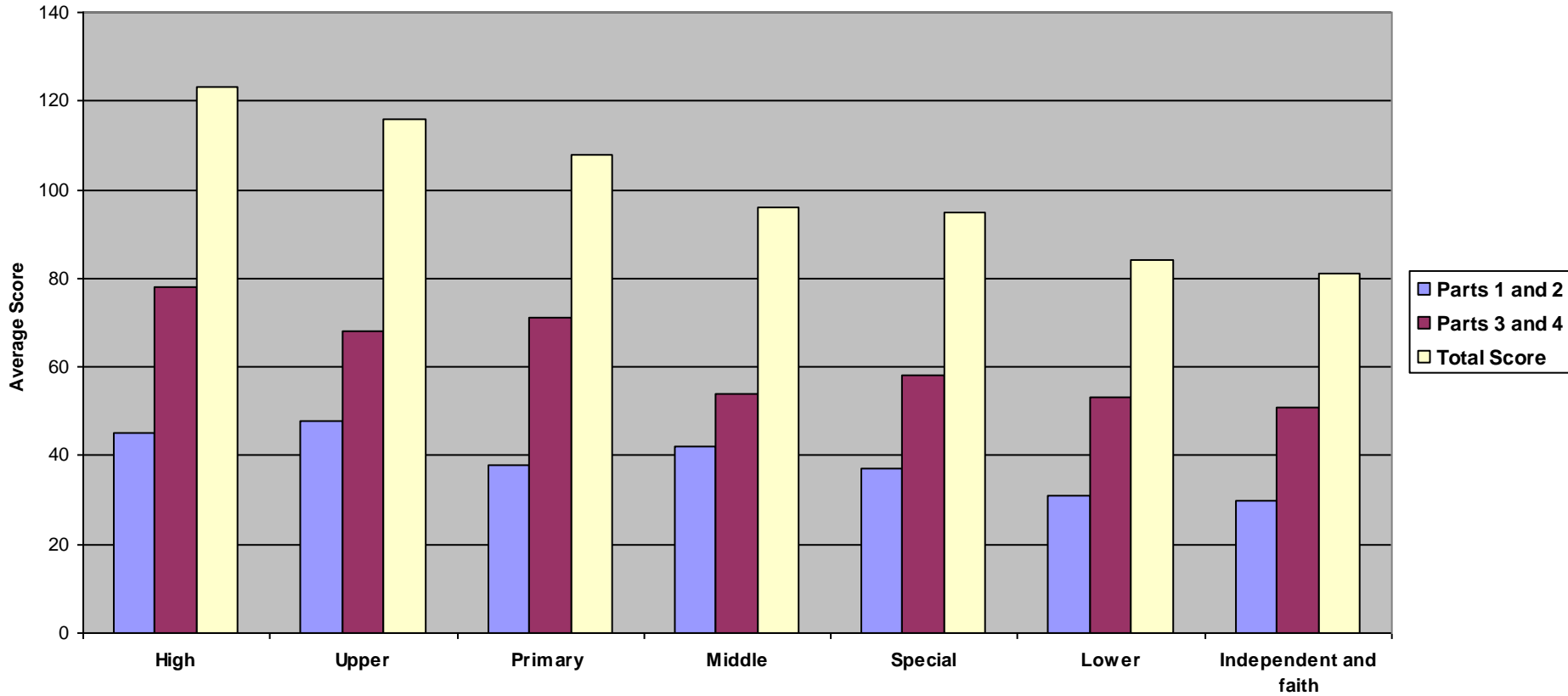

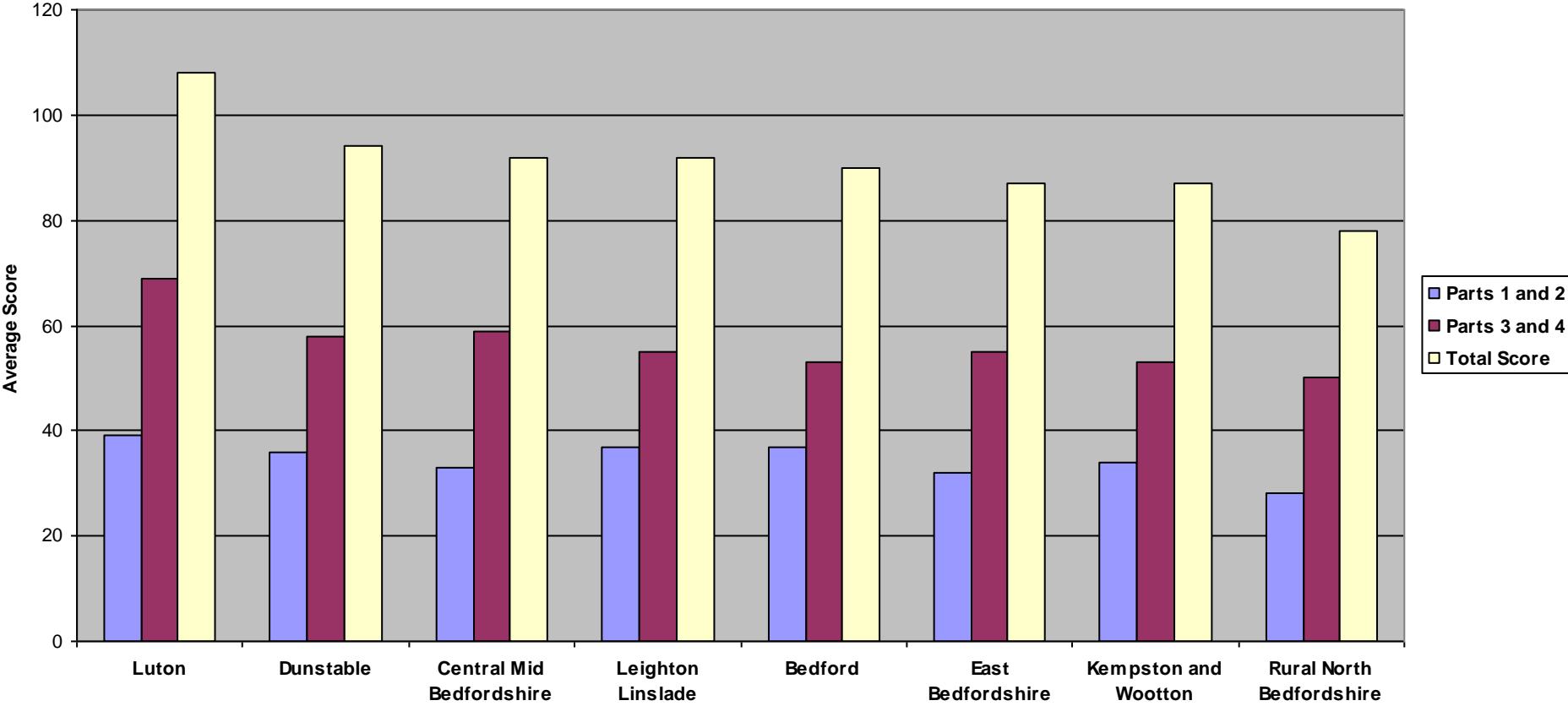
The Average School
